Jiva means life. The Jiva career guidance system helps the young person discover how a career can become an extension of his/her life.



A Values Based Approach


Jiva interprets ancient Indian values through simple activities. Participants introspect and work out what career means to them from a lifelong perspective.



About the Student Workshop

Activity Based and Student Led

This one-day workshop comprises a series of activities following the Career Discovery Path explained below. Jiva aims at helping students make rational career decisions and learn skills for life-long self-mediation of the labour market. The facilitator creates an environment for career discovery. Students engage with the topics in the Career Discovery Path through a wide variety of interesting activities including games, tests, inventories and time for quiet introspection. They record their learnings in their personal Jiva workbook.



Career Discovery Path

The workshop follows the career discovery path with the following key elements:

Understand Myself

Discover personal potentials through:

- Aptitude Tests
- InterestInventories
- GuidedIntrospection
- Hobbies
- Accomplishments
- Academic History

Understand World of Work Skills to interrogate a career before

making a choice:

- Courses and Streams
- New careers
- Eligibilities
- Qualifications

Develop Career Alternatives Decision Making:

- Identifying 3 to 4 careers matched to one's potentials
- Making back up plans

Career Preparation

Matching career alternatives with preparation tasks:

- Plotting educational and career paths and identifying milestones for the next 4 to 5 years
- Identifying specific preparation activities (e.g., entrance exams, portfolio, work experience, job shadowing)

Tests, Psychometry and Assessments

Jiva uses a comprehensive and modern method of assessment that blends quantitative and qualitative methods. Both methods are based on the Multiple Potentials Framework. Jiva uses a special algorithm to combine quantitative and qualitative data to come to a holistic understanding of the student's potentials.

Jiva Career Report

Students who go through the Jiva Workshop receive an individualised career report. The Report is about 10 to 15 pages long, and presents: the student's potential profile, recommended subject streams, suitable career alternatives and detailed career paths for each of the suggested alternatives.

Workshop Details

Individualised Workshops:

These are one-on-one workshops where one family and one or more counsellors work together. The workshop is tailored to meet the specific needs of the family. Individualized attention is provided exclusively for one student.

Workshop Process:

- Initial interactions are held with the parents for the counsellor to learn more about the child's history, accomplishments and inclinations.
- In parallel the student engages with the Jiva Workshop activities for the rest of the day.
- The workshop concludes with a **joint session** between the family (parents and student) and counsellor to discuss the outcomes of the workshop and jointly draw up a career development blueprint.
- The day's findings and outcomes are sent to the family in the form of an individualised Career Report.

Small Group Workshops:

These are workshops where small groups of two to three students interact with one or more counsellors. The workshop is tailored to the specific needs of the group. Individualized attention is provided for each student and his or her family.

The workshop process followed is similar to the Individualised format.
